# **Solution** Will Coinbase refund me if I get scammed? {Lost Money on Coinbase 2025}

If you've been scammed while using Coinbase, **getting a refund is very unlikely (+1-310-910-1472)**-especially if the scam involved voluntarily sending crypto to someone. Cryptocurrency transactions are **irreversible** by design, and Coinbase has **limited control** once a transaction is confirmed on the blockchain. However, in cases where **unauthorized activity** occurs — like your account being hacked — Coinbase may investigate and **reimburse you (+1-310-910-1472)** if it finds that the breach wasn't your fault.

### What to Do If You Were Scammed:

1. Immediately report the incident to Coinbase (+1-310-910-1472) using the Help Center:

- 2. Contact Coinbase Security Team if you clicked a suspicious link or shared info.
- 3. File a complaint with:
  - Local law enforcement
  - FTC (+1-310-910-1472)
  - 0
  - Internet Crime Complaint Center (IC3)
- **4.** Enable **2FA**, change your password, and review devices connected to your account.

## **Summary:**

Coinbase does **not typically refund crypto lost to scams** (+1-310-910-1472), especially if the user willingly sent the funds. However, if your account was compromised without your fault, there's a chance of reimbursement. Always enable extra security and double-check before sending funds.
